Don Lannoye, County Attorney, reviewed the process and procedure of the meeting. Followed by that he read, for the record, the Resolution that was being considered. Chairman Grochow asked for any input from the Commissioners. Commissioner Lilienthal reviewed the Planning and Zoning Conditional Use Permit and updated that some of the past concerns were addressed at prior Planning and Zoning meeting. Commissioner Hennen spoke on the approach and expressed that the current plan should not allow for nothing short of a temporary asphalt plant, claiming environmental concerns are limited to this site. Keeping costs to the road repair is a major objective of the Board according to Commissioner Hennen. Commissioner Koch commented that Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MN PCA) has some of the strictest laws in the nation and therefore doesn't believe there would be much environmental danger involved. Commissioner Saxton commented that he felt the Environmental Assessment Worksheet (EAW) would be a waste of county dollars.
